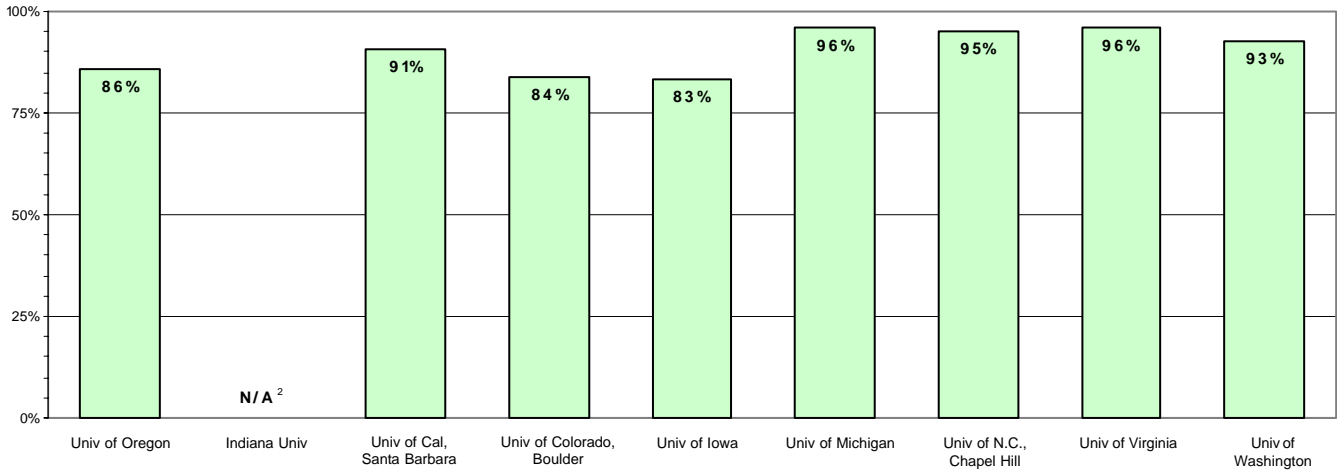


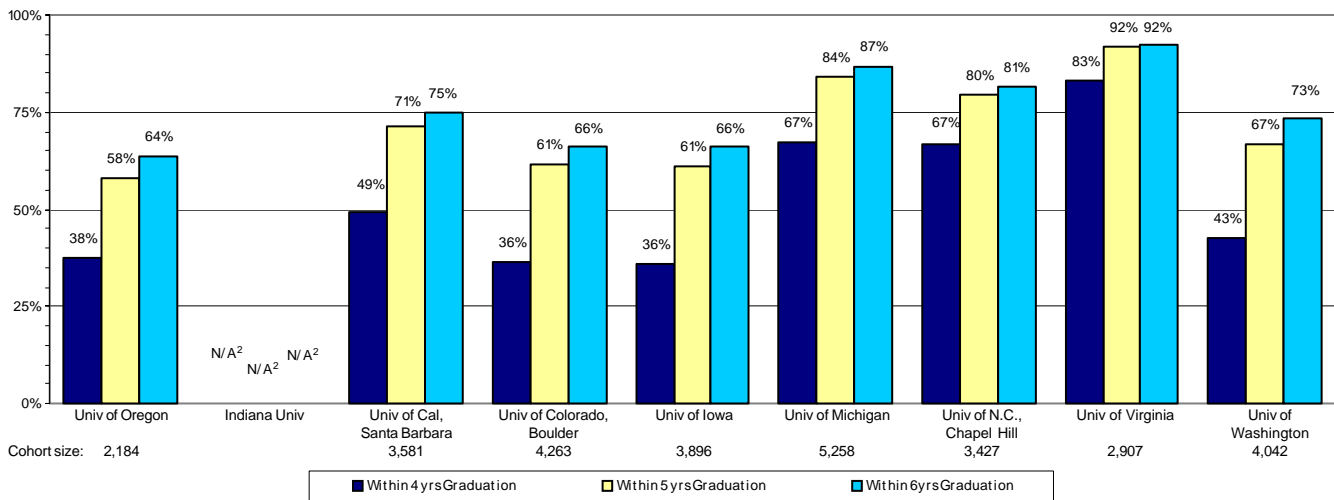

<sup>1</sup> First-time freshmen are defined as a GED or High School transfer taking 12 credit hours or more for a current admission term. Cohort groups are based on fall term enrollment only. The retention rate is the percentage of the cohort group that enrolled at the beginning of the second year of study. Graduation rate is the percentage of the cohort group that graduated, with the graduation rate being an accumulative percentage.
