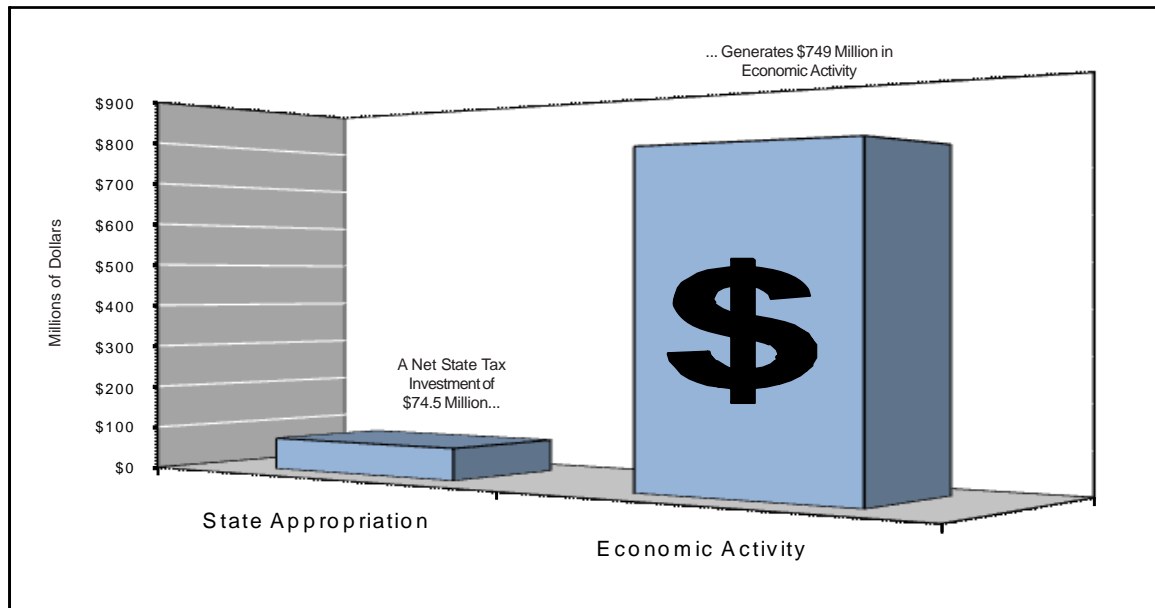


## UO Impact On The Economy

### The University of Oregon fuels the economic growth of Oregon

with research grants and contracts, federal financial aid, out-of-state student spending, private gifts, construction contracts, intercollegiate and national athletic events, and cultural events.

It is also the **largest employer in Lane County.**



### Adding Up The Contributions Statewide:

(For Fiscal Year 2007-8)

Employee Payroll	\$340 million
Materials and Supplies	158 million
Construction Contracts	54 million
Student Spending <sup>1</sup>	<u>197 million</u>
<b>Total</b>	<b>\$749 million</b>

### A Good Customer

In 2007-8, the university conducted business with nearly **7,129 vendors** spending **over \$207.1 million dollars.**  
(*\$128.0 million with Oregon vendors.*)

90% of those vendors were small businesses.
