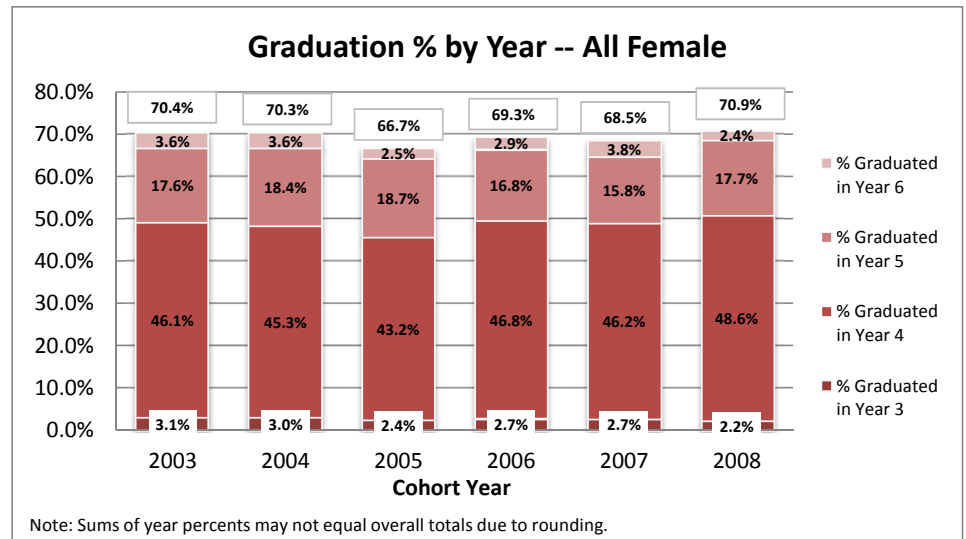

When one looks at retention and graduation rates for subcategories of students within first-time, full-time freshmen cohorts, it is important to remember that some of those subcategories (e.g., non-resident aliens) will contain small numbers, and small changes in those numbers can look like large changes in rates.
