
Retention and Graduation for First-time Full-time Students* (FTF) with First-term Major in CAS Humanities **Retention to Second Year**









Retention and Graduation for First-time Full-time Students* (FTF) with First-term Major in CAS Humanities Retention to Second Year












Retention and Graduation for First-time Full-time Students* (FTF) with First-term Major in CAS Humanities Graduation within Five Years








