





Retention and Graduation for First-time Full-time Students* (FTF) with First-term Major in CAS Social Sciences Retention to Second Year








Retention and Graduation for First-time Full-time Students* (FTF) with First-term Major in CAS Social Sciences Graduation within Five Years

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
Retention and Graduation for First-time Full-time Students* (FTF) with First-term Major in CAS Social Sciences Graduation within Six Years
