



Retention and Graduation for First-time Full-time Students* (FTF) with First-term Major in Lundquist College of Business *Retention to Second Year*





Cohorts Entering Fall 2018 to 2022 by First Generation Status Retention to Year 2 in/out of Lundquist College of Business






Retention and Graduation for First-time Full-time Students* (FTF) with First-term Major in Lundquist College of Business Graduation within Four Years








Cohorts Entering Fall 2015 to 2019 by Students of Color Graduated within 4 Years in/out of Lundquist College of Business



Retention and Graduation for First-time Full-time Students* (FTF) with First-term Major in Lundquist College of Business Graduation within Four Years









Retention and Graduation for First-time Full-time Students* (FTF) with First-term Major in Lundquist College of Business Graduation within Five Years



Retention and Graduation for First-time Full-time Students* (FTF) with First-term Major in Lundquist College of Business *Graduation within Five Years*








Retention and Graduation for First-time Full-time Students* (FTF) with First-term Major in Lundquist College of Business *Graduation within Six Years*


Retention and Graduation for First-time Full-time Students* (FTF) with First-term Major in Lundquist College of Business Graduation at Four, Five, and Six Years


