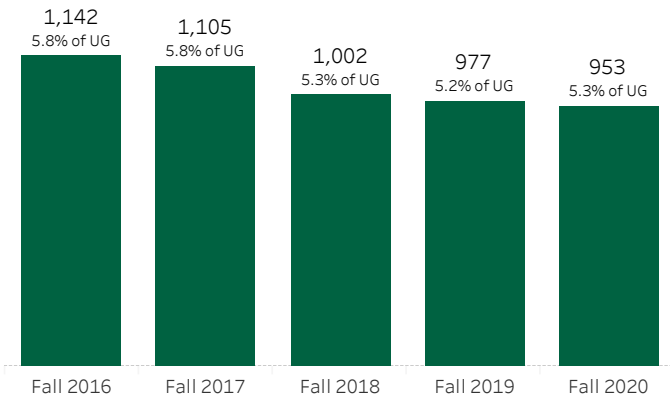


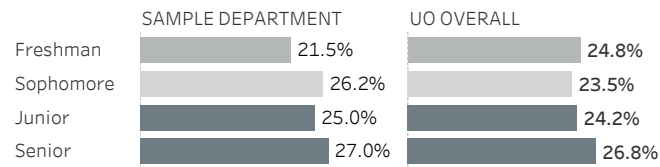

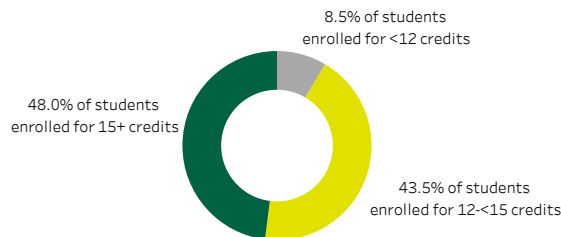


CLASS STANDING, Fall 2020



6.9% have declared additional majors

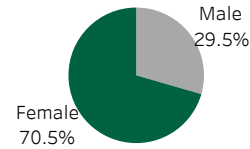
CREDITS ENROLLED, Fall 2020



At the UO in Fall 2020, 56.6% of undergraduate students were enrolled for 15 or more hours, 34.7% were enrolled for 12-<15 hours, and 8.7% were enrolled for <12 hours.

GENDER



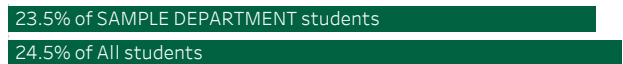
During these same terms, 44.7% of UO undergraduate students were male and 55.3% were female

UNDERREPRESENTED MINORITY STUDENTS



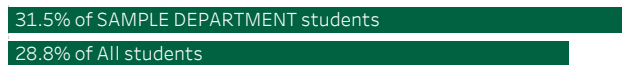

PELL ELIGIBILITY*



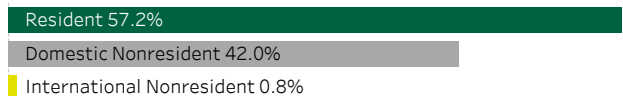
Students offered a Pell grant during the same academic year

RESIDENCY



During these same terms, 56.2% of UO undergraduate students were Oregon residents, 39.2% were domestic nonresidents and 4.5% were international nonresidents

STUDENT TYPE



During these same terms, 82.1% of UO undergraduate students matriculated from high school, 17.1% matriculated from another institution of higher education and 0.8% matriculated from elsewhere.

*Note that international students are not eligible for Pell Grants, and are not asked about first generation status during the admission process. International students are included in the percentage calculation for both measures.

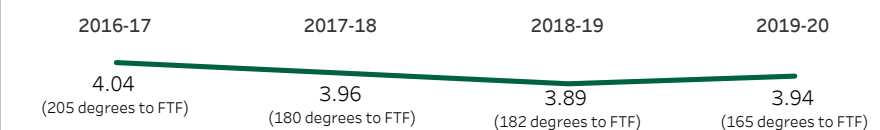

**Note on GRADUATION RATES (above): these graduation rates will be higher than other institutional graduation rates. Students who have persisted to the third year are more likely to graduate than the average FTF in their first term.

****Note on GRADUATION RATES (above):** these graduation rates will be higher than other institutional graduation rates. Students who declare a major later in their academic career have persisted further in their academic career. As students persist further in their academic career, they are more likely to graduate.
